

ORDINANCE NO. 907

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MEADE, KANSAS TO ALLOW FOR ANGLE PARKING ON THE NORTH HALF OF WEST PLAINS STREET BETWEEN FOWLER STREET AND SPRINGLAKE STREET AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MEADE:

SECTION 1. The Code of the City of Meade is hereby amended by adding a section which reads as follows:

16-2.12 PARKING IN BUSINESS DISTRICT

- 16-2.12.1 **ANGLE PARKING ON WEST PLAINS.** Parking on West Plains Street between Fowler Street and Meade Center Street shall be at a 45-degree angle. Parking on the North half of West Plains Street between Fowler Street and Springlake Street shall be at a 45-degree angle.
- 16-2.12.2 **ANGLE PARKING ON MEADE CENTER.** Parking on Meade Center Street between Grant Street and West Plains Street shall be at a 45-degree angle.
- 16-2.12.3 **PENALTY.** Any person convicted of illegal parking shall be fined in an amount not to exceed \$100.00.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its summary of publication in the Official City Newspaper.
