

## **ORDINANCE NO. 914**

### **AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 2, OF CHAPTER 3 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MEADE, KANSAS, AMENDING CMB LICENSING REQUIREMENTS WITHIN THE CITY OF MEADE, KANSAS, AND REPEALING ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MEADE:

**SECTION 1.** Article 3-2.2 of Chapter 3 of the Code of the City of Meade, Kansas pertaining to Temporary Short-Term Service is hereby amended to read as follows:

#### **APPLICATION.**

Any person desiring a license shall make an application to the governing body of the City and accompany the application by the required license fee for each place of business for which the person desires the license. The application shall be verified, and upon a form prepared by the attorney general of the State of Kansas, and shall contain:

- i. The name and residence of the applicant and how long he or she has resided within the State of Kansas;
- ii. The particular place for which a license is desired;
- iii. The name of the owner of the premises upon which the place of business is located;
- iv. The names and addresses of all persons who hold any financial interest in the particular place of business for which a license is desired.
- v. A statement that the applicant is a citizen of the United States and not less than 21 years of age and that he or she has not within two years immediately preceding the date of making application been convicted of a felony or any crime involving moral turpitude, or been adjudged guilty of drunkenness, or driving a motor vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or the violation of any other intoxicating liquor law of any state or of the United States;

The application shall be accompanied by a statement, signed by the applicant, authorizing any governmental agency to provide the City with any information pertinent to the application. One copy of such application shall immediately be transmitted to the City Clerk for investigation of the applicant. It shall be the duty of the City Clerk to cause an investigation with the Kansas Bureau of Investigation to determine whether such applicant is qualified as a licensee under the provisions of this chapter. The application shall be scheduled for consideration by the governing body at the earliest meeting consistent with current notification requirements.

**SECTION 2. REPEAL.** Any ordinance or parts of ordinances specifically in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance insofar as they conflict, shall be and are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its summary of publication in the Official City Newspaper.
