ORDINANCE NO. 915

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 3, OF CHAPTER 16 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MEADE, KANSAS, PERTAINING TO SPECIAL PURPOSE VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY OF MEADE, KANSAS, AND REPEALING ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MEADE:

SECTION 1. Article 3.4 of Chapter 16 of the Code of the City of Meade, Kansas is hereby amended to read as follows:

PROHIBITION ON HIGHWAY TRAVEL. No special purpose vehicle shall be operated on any interstate highway, federal highway, or state highway; provided, however, that the provisions of the Section shall not prohibit a special purpose vehicle from crossing a federal or state highway.

SECTION 2. Article 3.6 of Chapter 16 of the Code of the City of Meade, Kansas is hereby amended to read as follows:

SAME; INSURANCE REQUIRED; PENALTY. Every owner of a special purpose vehicle shall provide liability coverage in accordance with Section 200 of the 2021 Standard Traffic Ordinance, and amendments thereto, or similar Ordinance in effect, and the Kansas Automobile Injury Reparations Act, K.S.A. 40-3101, et seq., and amendments thereto. All provisions of Section 200 of the 2021 Standard Traffic Ordinance, and amendments thereto, or similar Ordinance in effect, including penalty provisions, shall be applicable to all owners and operators of special purpose vehicle.

SECTION 3. Article 3.7 of Chapter 16 of the Code of the City of Meade, Kansas is hereby amended to read as follows:

COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER ORDINANCES. Every driver of a special purpose vehicle must abide by and comply with the provisions of Ordinance No. 911, incorporating by reference the 2021 Standard Traffic Ordinance, and amendments thereto, or similar Ordinance in effect.

SECTION 4. Article 3.10.3 of Chapter 16 of the Code of the City of Meade, Kansas is hereby amended to read as follows:

Prior to the issuance of the registration and license, each applicant for special purpose vehicle license shall first present such vehicle for an official inspection. The official inspections will be conducted by the City Administrator or Municipal Court Clerk. If, upon inspection and completion of the registration application, such vehicle is found to be in safe mechanical condition, and upon establishing proof of liability insurance and payment of the fees herein provided, a license tag shall be issued to the owner. The license shall be displayed in such a manner as to be clearly visible from the rear of the vehicle. The license number on the application will be recorded and then filed with the City Clerk.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its summary of publication in the Official City Newspaper.
